

Addendum to Campus Housing Contract  
Charleston Bridge

This agreement is binding for the Fall 2018 academic term for students ("students") participating in the Charleston Bridge program with Trident Technical College ("TTC") and College of Charleston ("College").

Charleston Bridge students are required to live in a College of Charleston residence hall and purchase a College of Charleston freshmen resident meal plan. Students are responsible for full payment of housing and meal plan fees regardless of withdrawal or dismissal from the Charleston Bridge program or removal from the residence hall. Residency waivers will only be granted to students with extreme extenuating circumstances who provide documentation to Campus Housing to support their waiver request, such decision to be in the sole discretion of the College. Campus Housing collaborates with many campus partners to make the most informed decision possible, in order to support students and the mission of the Charleston Bridge program.

Students will be assigned roommates who are Charleston Bridge students. The College reserves the right to relocate a student from one room assignment to another housing assignment. The College reserves the right to assign students to suites that are occupied by College students who are not participating in the Charleston Bridge program.

Students may be immediately removed from the residence hall for the following reasons:

- Violation of the Student Code of Conduct and/or Campus Housing and Residence Life policies or rules;
- Failure to timely pay the housing, meal plan, and or program fees; or
- Withdrawal or Dismissal from the Charleston Bridge program.

Students who are not accepted for Spring 2019 admission to the College will not be eligible to continue living in a College residence hall, and must check-out of the residence hall no later than noon on December 13, 2018. Students are responsible for removing all personal belongings and leaving the room in its initial move-in condition. Personal belongings remaining in the residence hall will be removed by College personnel and disposed of. The College does not accept responsibility for student property at any time.

Students who are granted admission to the College for Spring 2019 are still required to live in campus housing as determined by the housing contract.

This Addendum, for and in consideration of the mutual agreements hereafter set forth, is entered into between the undersigned student, and the College of Charleston, Charleston, South Carolina for accommodations for the Fall 2018 academic term.
